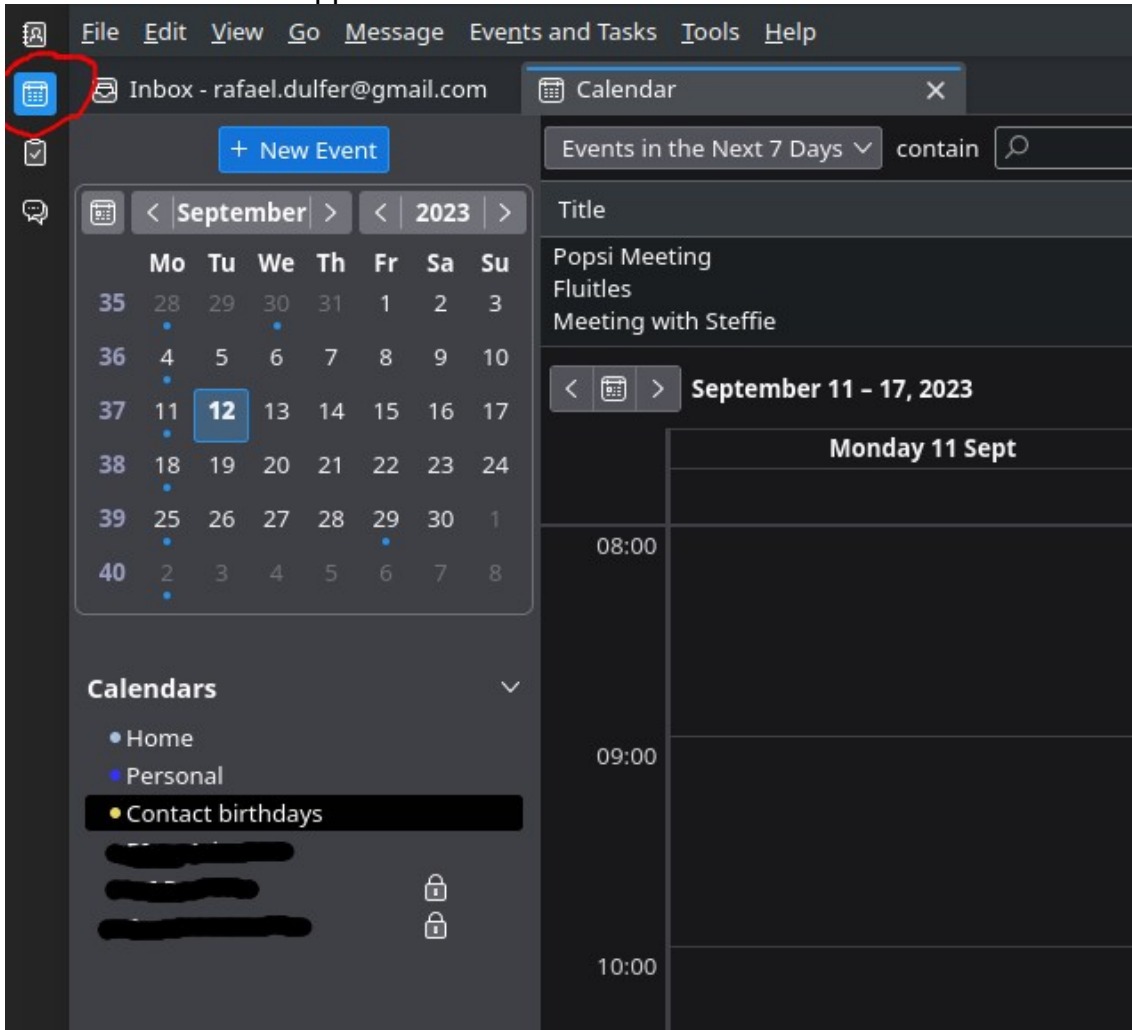
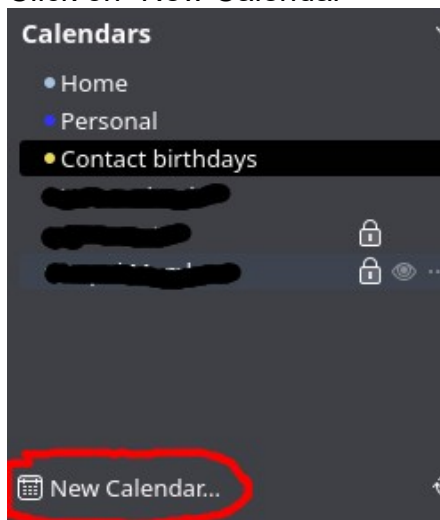


Usually, clicking the “Subscribe to Calendar” button will work for most devices. However, some device + calendar application combos will not immediately subscribe you to the calendar but will just import the events one time. If you notice that new events are not being added to your calendar, it is likely that this happened. In this case, you need to manually subscribe to the calendar. How you do this depends on the application you are using. For this example, we will use Thunderbird, but the process should be similar for other programs.

1. Go to the calendar application



2. Click on “New Calendar”



3. Choose "On the Network" and click "Next"

Your calendar can be stored on your computer or be stored on a server in order to access it remotely or share it with your friends or co-workers.
